GOLF






The course is a treasure, one that has eluded many that underestimate it. Woodstock's golf program has inspired many golfers I know to passionately pursue the game.

In 1897, Woodstock Club's original golf course became one of the first nine-hole courses west of the Appalachians.

Today, the Tom Bendelow-designed nine-hole course boasts flat, original greens, a PGA professional staff and devilish par fours. The bent-grass course is heavily lined with mature trees and meticulously maintained with pride and professionalism.

Nearly a century ago, Woodstock Club began building its national reputation as a premier tennis venue. In the 1920s, its seven clay courts became biennial home to the Western Open. In 1969, it was appointed host to the U.S. Clay Court Championships.

In 1972, Woodstock introduced paddle (platform) tennis to the city. Today, eight clay tennis courts, two aluminum paddle tennis courts, a warming hut and tennis house reflect the enduring tradition of tennis—both recreational and competitive—at Woodstock.

In 1927, the first pool at Woodstock Club opened amid formal terraces, making it the perfect classically styled setting for a nighttime exhibition by eight Olympic swimmers in 1929.

Today, the scene is both more relaxed and more robust, with three pools: one for tykes and toddlers, another for youthful rough and tumble, and a large sparkling one bringing everyone together for exercise and activity. The club's storied swimming program helps children master skills and learn sportsmanship through active interclub rivalry. Adults swim fitness laps, and the generations leisurely mingle poolside.



DINING




